3. We take your privacy very seriously. In this document, we describe our Privacy Policy. We explain to you in the clearest way possible what information we collect, how we use it and what rights you have in relation to it.
4. It explains what these technologies are and why we use them, as well as your rights to control our use of them.

6. Capitalized terms used and not otherwise defined in the Privacy Policy have the meanings given to those terms in our [Terms and Conditions](#).
7. IF THERE ARE ANY TERMS IN THIS PRIVACY POLICY THAT YOU DO NOT AGREE WITH, PLEASE DISCONTINUE USE OF OUR WEBSITE, APP AND OUR SERVICES.
8. Please read this Privacy Policy carefully as it will help you make informed decisions about sharing your Personal Information with us.
9. Except as explained below, we will not disclose any of your personally identifiable information, and will not sell or rent lists containing your information to third parties. We may disclose information when it has your permission to do so or under special circumstances, such as when it believes in good faith that the law requires it. We may also use such information to contact individuals for marketing purposes.
10. If you are a resident in the European Union we protect your Personal Information in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR). If not, we will take all necessary measures to protect your Personal Information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.
11. The Personal Information that you provide to us must be true, complete and accurate, and you must notify us of any changes to such Personal Information.
12. We collect Personal Information that you voluntarily provide to us when registering in our Website or App, expressing an interest in obtaining information about us or our

services, when participating in activities on the Website or in the App or otherwise contacting us.

13. The Personal Information that we collect depends on the context of your interactions with us and other users of Gaming platforms, the choices you make and the products and features you use
14. Like many businesses, we also collect information through Cookies and similar technologies. You can find out more about this in our Cookies Policy.

2. LEGAL BASIS AND PURPOSE OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

DATRES Skill Games a.s. processes your personal data under a number of legal bases:

- **performance of a contract** between you and the Controller under Article 6 (1) b) GDPR,
- **legitimate interest** of the Controller in direct marketing (in particular for sending commercial messages and newsletters) under Article 6 (1) f) GDPR. If we use your personal data for the purposes of our legitimate interest, we always balance our interest and your right to privacy, for example we offer an option to simply refuse marketing messages and we also use pseudonymized data or non-personalized data, if possible,
- **compliance with a legal obligation** under Article 6 (1) c) GDPR in particular to comply with our legal obligations.

3. THE PURPOSE OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

1. for the purpose of providing Skills4wins Services and fulfilling our contractual obligations (legal basis: performance of a contract and legitimate interest) DATRES Skill Games a.s. processes your Personal Data in order to be able to offer you Skills4wins Services on the basis of a contract concluded with you. We use the data, for example, to process your payment and any (possible) financial winnings or compensation, and we provide the information necessary for the payment of the winnings. If you contact us, we will use the information you provide to answer your questions or resolve your complaint.
2. for the purpose of complying with our legal obligations (legal basis: compliance with legal obligations). DATRES Skill Games a.s. processes your personal data to comply with its legal obligations.
3. for the purpose of handling complaints and court proceedings (legal basis: legitimate interest). DATRES Skill Games a.s. is authorized to process Personal Data related to the handling of complaints, debt collection and court proceedings. We are also

authorized to process data in order to prevent fraud and misuse of our Services and to ensure the security of data, systems and networks.

4. for the purpose of communication with marketing customers (legal basis: legitimate interest). DATRES Skill Games a.s. processes your Personal Data to contact you regarding Skills4wins Services and inform you of related changes. Your Personal Data is also used to market Skills4wins Services.
5. for the purpose of improving quality and trend analysis (legal basis: legitimate interest). To improve the quality of Skills4wins Services, DATRES Skill Games a.s. may also process information about the manner in which you use the Services, e.g. in the form of analysis of trends in the use of Skills4wins Services. Personal data may also be used, for example, for the purpose of customer satisfaction reports, so that we are able to ensure that our Services meet your needs. Whenever possible, we only use aggregate data that is not personalized for this purpose.
6. you may be asked to consent to the processing of Personal Data in certain parts of the Services provided by DATRES Skill Games a.s. You may withdraw your consent at any time.

4. SCOPE OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

Personal data we collect and process may be divided into two main categories: **user data** and **analytical data**

USER DATA

- login name, information about your age and e-mail address. It is at your discretion whether we will process your profile photograph or leave your account without a photograph.
 - If you want to be a user eligible to win a Prize, we will process the following information about you necessary for registration:
 - your location, a color copy of the national identity card (front and back) or the driving license (front and back) or the passport (pages that contain the Player's photograph and identification data) and the related Personal Data, i.e. the resulting Personal Data;
 - bank account details: bank name, bank address, account holder name, IBAN number, BIC / SWIFT code in pdf. Payment services are provided by our partner, please read their Privacy Policy.

1. The legal basis for the processing is the performance of a contract (i.e. the provision of Services consisting in the possibility of participating in games of skill we operate).
 2. In order to send commercial messages regarding our products and Services, we may process your Personal Data in the scope of name, surname, gender, e-mail address, transaction history, IP address, Cookies, data on visits to our Websites, behavioral data and other data. Such processing is based on our legitimate interest and your Personal Data will be processed for the period of validity of your registration as a Game User, or until you unsubscribe from commercial messages. 3. We are also entitled to process other information that you voluntarily provide to us, such as: information that you provide as part of the evaluation of our Services, marketing consent or refusal, information that you provide to us by phone or e-mail.

ANALYTICAL DATA

1. Although we do not normally use analytical data to identify you as an individual, we identify you using analytical data from time to time, either separately or in combination or in association with user data. In such situations, under valid legal regulations, analytical data can also be considered Personal Data, and we handle them as such.
2. We collect the following anonymized data about the technical device used for Skills4wins Services: device type, device identification number, country, IP address, search engine type and version, operating system, ad identifier of your device.
3. We collect information about how you use the Skills4wins Services: time spent within the Skills4wins Services, communication within the Skills4wins Services, information about the games you play through the Skills4wins Services, information about your results in individual games, the URL of the Website you visit before Skills4wins, the date and time of your visits to the Skills4wins Services, heatmaps and other user statistics. Based on the data collected, an automatic decision, such as a decision on which opponent you will play in the next game, who will start the game, etc., may be taken in order to exclude the element of chance.

COOKIES

1. Our Website uses cookies. Cookies are small text files stored by the browser on your end device. Cookies do not cause any damage. They enable the analysis of Website utilization, support user-friendliness, which means they also serve the users and at the same time they collect statistical data about Website user behavior and perform analysis to improve our offer.
2. If Cookies are required, data is processed on the basis of your declaration of consent, our legitimate interest in order to optimize the user-friendliness of the Website and provide you with the best information and Services or in order to fulfill our contractual obligations. operator, we have a legitimate interest in a simple analysis of the utilization of our Website in order to make it as user-friendly and efficient as possible, and to be able to continually develop it. FACEBOOK- PIXEL (PERSONALIZATION TOOL)

Your Personal Information may be accessible to law enforcement or other

authorities pursuant to a lawful request. Where required by law, international transfers of Personal Information will be supported by an adequacy mechanism.

6. THIRD PARTIES – RECIPIENTS

1. We only share your Personal Data within Skills4wins organization and only when reasonably necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy.
2. We only share your Personal Data with a third party outside Skills4wins under the following conditions:
 - For the purpose stated in this Privacy Policy, we share data with authorized entities that provide us with the Services. We disclose your Personal Data to a third party to the extent necessary for the provision of the Skills4wins Services. We may also provide your Personal Data to our affiliates, subcontractors or authorized entities that provide us with the Services (including data storage, accounting, sales and The Privacy Policy of DATRES Skill Games a.s. 10 z 14 marketing, IT Services) to process the data for us, and entities that provide payment Services in order to process your payments.
 - If Personal Data is processed by a third party on behalf of Skills4wins, we take appropriate contractual and organizational measures to ensure that your Personal Data is processed solely for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy, in accordance with all applicable laws, in accordance with our instructions and in accordance with applicable confidentiality obligations and security measures.
 - For legal bases and based on legal procedures we may share your Personal Data with a third party outside the Skills4wins Group if we believe in good faith that access to and use of the Personal Data is reasonably necessary to: (i) comply with all applicable laws and regulations or court decisions; (ii) detect, prevent and resolve fraud, crime, security and technical issues; or (iii) protect interests, property and safety of Skills4wins, Users and the public, if permitted by legal regulations. If possible, we will inform you of such Personal Data processing.
 - For other legitimate reasons: If DATRES Skill Games a.s. is a party to a merger, acquisition or sale of a business, we are entitled to transfer your Personal Data to a third party involved. However, we will continue to maintain the confidentiality of all your Personal Data. We will inform all our affected Users about the transfer of Personal Data and notify them that Personal Data will be subject to a different privacy policy.

7. RETENTION PERIOD

1. DATRES Skill Games a.s. will not store your Personal Data longer than permitted by law and as necessary to provide the Skills4wins Services or the respective parts thereof. The retention period depends on the nature of the information and the purpose of its processing. The maximum retention period may therefore vary depending on the purpose.
2. Most of the User's Personal Data related to his Skills4wins Services user account will be anonymized or deleted no later than 365 days after the User cancels this account. After the expiration of this period, only Personal Data of the User specified in his user account, the processing of which is required by law or which is reasonably necessary to comply with our legal obligations or satisfy our legitimate interests, such as handling complaints, accounting, internal reporting and settlement, may be stored. All User's Personal Data related to his user account will be deleted 10 years after the User has cancelled his Skills4wins Services account, except for Personal Data necessary in certain exceptional situations, e.g. legal proceedings.
3. Analytical data of Users who no longer have a Skills4wins Services account will be anonymized or stored for a maximum of 365 days after the User cancels this account.

8. DIRECT MARKETING

1. The User has the right to prohibit us from using his Personal Data for the purposes of direct marketing, market research and direct marketing profiling. The User exercises this right by contacting us at the above address or using the functions of the Gaming platforms or by refusing to receive direct marketing messages.

9. COMPLAINTS

1. If you believe that we are processing Personal Data in violation of applicable data protection legislation, you are entitled to lodge a complaint with the relevant Personal Data protection authority [https:// www.uoou.cz](https://www.uoou.cz). You are also entitled to lodge your complaint with the competent Personal Data protection authority in your country of residence.

10. UNSOLICITED DATA

1. You can provide us with your ideas for new products or modifications to existing products and other unsolicited contributions (collectively "Unsolicited Data"). Unsolicited data is not deemed confidential and we may freely copy, use, share and distribute it without a restriction or license.

11. INFORMATION SECURITY

1. We apply administrative, organizational, technical and physical measures in order to protect the Personal Data we collect and process. These measures include, but are not limited to, encryption, pseudonimization, firewalls, security devices and access rights systems. The purpose of our security controls is to maintain an adequate level

of data confidentiality, integrity, availability, resilience and ability to recover. We regularly test the security of Skills4wins Services, systems and other assets.

2. If you are not satisfied with our services, you can contact the Central Inspectorate of the Czech Republic – Czech Trade Inspection Authority, Štěpánská 567/15, 120 00 Prague 2, Czech Republic.
3. In the event of a data breach, which is likely to have a negative impact on the privacy of Users, occurring despite our security measures, the relevant Users and other affected parties, including the competent authorities, will be contacted as soon as necessary under the applicable Personal Data Protection legislation.

12. PROTECTION INFORMATION

1. We have implemented appropriate technical and organizational security measures designed to protect the security of any Personal Information we process. However, please also remember that we cannot guarantee that the internet itself is 100% secure. Although we will do our best to protect your Personal Information, transmission of Personal Information to and from our website is at your own risk. You should only access the services within a secure environment.

13. CHILDREN

1. We do not knowingly solicit data from or market to children under 15 years of age. If we notice that Personal Information from users less than 15 years of age has been collected, we will deactivate the account and take reasonable measures to promptly delete such data from our records.

14. PRIVACY RIGHTS

Skills4wins cares about your privacy Rights.

“Personal Information” or „Data“ is any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person (“Individual”). “Process” or “Processing” means any operation which is performed upon Personal Information, whether or not by automatic means, such as collection, recording, organization, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure, or destruction.

“Sensitive Data” or “Sensitive Personal Information” is a subset of Personal Information which, due to its nature, has been classified by law or by policy as deserving additional privacy and security protections. Sensitive Personal Information includes Personal Information regarding EU residents that is classified as a “Special Category of Personal Data” under EU law, which consists of the following data elements: (1) race or ethnic origin; (2) political opinions; (3) religious or philosophical beliefs; (4) trade union membership; (5) genetic data; (6) biometric data where Processed to uniquely identify a person; (6) health information; (7) sexual orientation or information about the Individual’s sex life; or (8) information relating to the commission of a criminal offense.

“Third Party” is any company, natural or legal person, public authority, agency, or body other than the Individual.

You have the right to be informed: We need to tell you what Personal Information is being collected, how it’s being used, how long it will be kept and whether it will be shared with any third parties. We hope this information we communicated in this Privacy Policy concisely and in plain language.

- The right to access: You can submit subject access requests, which oblige us to provide a copy of any personal data concerning the individual. We have one month to produce this information, although there are exceptions for requests that are manifestly unfounded, repetitive or excessive.
- The right to rectification: If you discover that the information an organisation holds on them is inaccurate or incomplete, you can request that it be updated. As with the right to access, we have one month to do this, and the same exceptions apply.
- The right to erasure (also known as ‘the right to be forgotten’): You can request that we erase your data in certain circumstances, such as when the Personal Information is no longer necessary, the Personal Information was unlawfully processed or it no longer meets the lawful ground for which it was collected. This includes instances where withdraws consent.
- The right to restrict processing: You can request that we limit the way an uses Personal Information. It’s an alternative to requesting the erasure of Personal Information, and might be used when you contest the accuracy your personal data or when you no longer needs the information but we requires it to establish, exercise or defend a legal claim.

- Rights related to automated decision making including profiling: The GDPR includes provisions for decisions made with no human involvement, such as profiling, which uses personal data to make calculated assumptions about individuals. We do not automated decision making including profiling.
